NC SYNOD ASSEMBLY, May 29-31, 2025.



Please be in prayer for the delegates of this year's assembly. Bishop Tim Smith has made the decision to retire prior to the end of his second term of office, and so the assembly will be electing a new bishop for the synod. The election follows an ecclesiastical protocol where anyone who is on the roster Word and Sacrament from any geographic location, can be nominated on the first ballot. If someone gets 2/3 of the votes, they are elected. If not, then a second ballot will be offered with names of all those nominated on the first ballot who desire to remain on the ballot.

Additional balloting continues, with a decreasing number of names on each ballot, until one person receives a predetermined percentage of the votes. This process could take as many as five ballots.
