FOR FURTHER THOUGHT

Jesus sets forth the steps for healing and reconciling personal conflict within a community. He uses some background from the Old Testament book of Deuteronomy, but expands the use with the inclusion of the full faith community when necessary.

For pastors and church leaders, handling conflict is often the most difficult responsibility assigned. Unresolved conflict is probably one of the things that most congregations (of any denomination) have in common.

CONSIDER

If you have ever been in a congregation that experienced conflict, reflect upon how Jesus’ steps for reconciliation were followed.

Jesus ends with the promise that “where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them.” How can families, communities, or congregations live into the promise Jesus gives us?
